1.3 Mental health education is separated from the education of surrounding disciplines

Some adult education schools teaching philosophy and means are too extreme, some professional teachers think that mental health education has nothing to do with their own, should be explained by professional teachers, as long as they complete the required teaching tasks can, rarely pay attention to mental health education. However, they did not realize that mental health education needs the participation of teachers of various professions and the cooperation between teachers and students. The

In order to ensure the orderly development of mental health education, it is necessary to have professional practitioners, improve the mental health education system, clarify the teaching objectives, and enrich the teaching content on this basis. Therefore, adult education schools should attach importance to mental health education, set up an excellent team of mental health teachers, and formulate teaching objectives and contents by professionals to ensure high-quality mental health education, so that every adult education student can receive mental health education, solve the psychological problems of students, so that adult education students have a healthy mental state, so as to form a sound personality. At the same time, adult education schools should regularly assess the ability of mental health education teachers, strengthen the training of teachers' professional ability, improve teachers' teaching ability and quality, so that teachers can understand students' doubts and problems, grasp the difficulties of mental health education, guide students to form correct ideas and concepts, and enable adult education students to realize their own value.

2.2 Establish a correct view of learning

Adult education students should set up correct learning concept and correct learning attitude. Need to start from several aspects: first, adult education students should establish a positive and optimistic attitude. Only when adult students have self-confidence, can they have the courage to pursue, take learning seriously, strive to improve themselves, and eliminate the psychology of pessimism and inferiority. Second, we must choose carefully. Adult education students should carefully choose what they learn and be careful about the learning process. The content they choose should be consistent with their work and what they are interested in, so as to generate interest in learning, and there will be no fluke psychology in the learning process. Finally, adult students should establish the consciousness of active learning. At this stage, the social competition is becoming increasingly fierce, and we should learn to take the initiative when we encounter opportunities and seize this hard-won opportunity. Adult education students need to seize learning opportunities, take the initiative to learn, master more knowledge, so as to get more opportunities in the work.

2.3 All teachers in the school shall work together to carry out mental health education

Mental health education is not only the work of psychological teachers, it needs the active participation of all professional teachers in the whole school, and the construction of an education system led by psychological teachers and the participation of other professional teachers. The large number of adult education students and the complicated source of students make it difficult for psychology teachers to conduct differentiated teaching for adult education students, and the teaching evaluation results are inaccurate. Therefore, in order to improve the quality of mental health education, it is necessary to participate in the whole school teachers, and penetrate the mental health education into the whole learning process of students to ensure the physical and mental health of students. In addition, some adult students have a very close relationship with a professional teacher, often communicate with the teacher about the problems they encounter, can know the psychological status of students, and generate mental health files, and psychological teachers assess the psychological status of students, timely find the problems of students, and take effective measures to solve them.

In the process of adult education, mental health education is very important for adult education students. Therefore, education staff should deeply analyze the psychological status of students, optimize mental health education methods, make students aware of their own problems, solve psychological problems under the guidance of teachers, provide quality learning services for adult education students, and improve the quality of adult education.
