The Specific Application of Flipped Classroom Model in Children's Guzheng Teaching

Abstract: The application of flipped classroom model in children's guzheng teaching is an innovative teaching method, which can improve students' active learning ability and learning effect. What are the similarities and differences between the performances of Liuyang River and those guzheng songs we have learned before? Finally, I will guide the students to discuss the questions they raised in class.

3.2 Students' feedback and assessment of the flipped classroom teaching model

First of all, flipped classroom can improve students' active learning ability. Through independent study before class, students can better understand the background knowledge related to the music and basically master the skills of guzheng performances. Then students can directly performance in the class and observe each other and find out the problems in performance. Students can present their own performances or share their musical understanding and experience in class, and promote mutual learning and growth through interaction and cooperation.
