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A Study on Social Support System for Rehabilitation Difficulties of Autistic Families - a Case Study of Guiyang

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Abstract: Family education and training institutions in Guiyang area provide professional rehabilitation guidance and consultation services for autistic families to help them improve their rehabilitation ability and promote the all-round development of autistic children. However, there are still insufficient resources and uneven levels of expertise. Therefore, it is recommended to strengthen the support and training of these institutions, improve their professional level and service quality, and strengthen the publicity and promotion of family education and training, so that more autistic families can benefit from the support and help of these institutions. **Keywords:** Autistic families; Rehabilitation dilemma; Social support system

Introduction:

Autism is a common developmental disorder in children that causes great distress to sufferers and their families. However, autistic families face many difficulties in the process of recovery, among which the lack of social support system is one of the main problems. Due to heavy economic burden and inconvenient transportation, some families are unable to reach rehabilitation centers far from home to receive professional rehabilitation services. Autistic people and their families often face difficulties in social interaction and interpersonal communication, and the Guiyang area lacks community organizations and activities that specifically provide social support for autistic people and families. The lack of a social support network leaves families with autism without channels to communicate and support each other in the face of difficult situations. Autistic patients and their families have great difficulties in the protection of rights and interests. The lack of formulation and effective implementation of relevant laws and regulations in Guiyang has led to inadequate protection of the rights and interests of autistic patients and their families in education, employment, and social participation. Due to the lack of awareness of autism and discrimination against special groups, some autistic families suffer unfair treatment in society. People with autism and their families face pressure and isolation from society, a lack of understanding and support. In response to the above practical difficulties, the following measures can be taken to improve: establish more autism rehabilitation centers and professional teams, provide comprehensive and personalized rehabilitation services, increase the training and introduction of professional talents, and improve the quality and level of rehabilitation services. Establish social support organizations and activities for autistic families, provide platforms for inter-family communication and mutual assistance, and promote social support and resource sharing for autistic families. Formulate and improve relevant laws and regulations, clarify the rights and interests of autistic patients and their families, and strengthen the maintenance and protection of their rights and interests. Strengthen the publicity and education of autism, improve social awareness of autism, reduce discrimination against autistic people and their families, and create an inclusive and supportive social atmosphere. Through the implementation of the above improvement measures, it can promote the rehabilitation of autistic families and improve the quality of life, increase the social attention and support for autistic patients, and establish a more inclusive and friendly social environment.

3. Countermeasures and suggestions to solve the rehabilitation dilemma of autistic families

3.1 Strengthen social awareness and publicity and education

According to the data, the publicity and education activities of autism rehabilitation in Guiyang area have achieved certain results. In the past few years, the Guiyang municipal government and related organizations have held more than 20 rehabilitation lectures and autism Day activities, with more than 5,000 participants. These activities disseminate autism knowledge to the public through publicity panels, lectures, interactive experiences and other forms, and improve the public's awareness of autism. Guiyang region also pays attention to the training and education of medical personnel and educators. In recent years, Guiyang has held a number of autism rehabilitation training courses, inviting domestic and foreign experts to give lectures and training, including doctors, rehabilitation teachers, special education teachers and so on. Through these training and educational activities, medical personnel and educators

have improved their awareness of autism and rehabilitation skills. In terms of family education and training, Guiyang region provides certain economic support and subsidies for autistic families. 3.2 Improve medical resources and professional services

Increase investment in autism rehabilitation, and increase the number and scale of medical institutions and rehabilitation centers. Establish more rehabilitation departments and specialized wards, provide more comprehensive rehabilitation services, improve the equipment level of medical facilities, introduce advanced rehabilitation equipment and technology, and improve the effectiveness and quality of rehabilitation treatment. Through the establishment of autism professional posts and on-the-job training programs, more doctors, therapists and other professionals are attracted to engage in autism rehabilitation work, and medical colleges are encouraged to offer autism-related professional courses to train more professionals. In addition, foreign professionals and experience can be introduced to improve the professional level and service quality of autism rehabilitation. The objective and accuracy of rehabilitation assessment can be ensured by establishing unified rehabilitation assessment standards and procedures. On the basis of the assessment, a personalized rehabilitation program should be formulated, corresponding rehabilitation goals and rehabilitation plans should be formulated according to the specific situation and needs of autistic children, and the implementation and supervision of rehabilitation programs should be strengthened to ensure the continuity and effectiveness of rehabilitation work. Autism rehabilitation is a comprehensive work, involving medicine, rehabilitation, education and other fields. Although some institutions and professionals have provided professional rehabilitation services, there are still some institutions with low professional level and unstable service quality. Therefore, it is necessary to further strengthen the training and supervision of rehabilitation institutions and professionals to improve their professional level and service quality. Through establishing the certification mechanism and evaluation system of rehabilitation institutions, strict evaluation and supervision can be carried out to ensure that the rehabilitation services provided by them meet the standards and requirements.

Conclusion:

Through the study of rehabilitation plight and social support system of families with autism in Guiyang area, this study revealed the impact of insufficient social cognition, lack of medical resources, economic pressure and other problems on rehabilitation.
