Diversified teaching methods such as group discussion, case study, practice exercise, etc., can be adopted to stimulate students' active learning awareness and creativity. We should focus on cultivating students' practical ability and provide them with rich practical opportunities, such as holding concerts and participating in musical performances. We can also cooperate with other professional institutions such as music colleges or concert halls to build practical training platforms and practice bases to provide more practical opportunities for students. Through cooperation with all walks of life, students are exposed

to the real environment of the music industry, and their practical ability and professional quality are cultivated. The second is to establish a "double degree" educational and teaching mode, that is, based on the school's own second-degree education, we should actively guide students to establish a second major learning course in addition to learning musicology major courses, so as to increase students' employment channels and enhance their competitiveness. The study of the second major also helps students to have a deeper understanding of relevant theories of musicology, and lays a solid foundation for improving students' comprehensive ability. The third is to make overall adjustments to the proportion of minor courses to make the types of minor courses more diversified. Micro-major courses can be built according to local characteristics and culture. Micro-major means that students can use the current Internet or practical activities to increase other knowledge content in their spare time, such as inviting local cultural celebrities and non-genetic inheritors to classroom teaching to explain more knowledge beyond the music major to students, which can not only promote the formation of students' ideological system, but also broaden their horizons and let them know the knowledge outside the professional course of musicology. Learning more diversified content in the whole music field environment can not only promote students' mastery of the basic knowledge of musicology, but also comprehensively improve their artistic and cultural connotation. Combining teaching content with excellent traditional culture is not only to promote traditional culture, but also to spread and develop aesthetic concepts.

Conclusion

With the development of China's society and economy to a higher level, the reform of higher education and teaching continues to deepen, which provides an opportunity for the educational and teaching reform of cultivating innovative talents in the musicology majors of higher normal colleges and universities.
