Foreword:

1. Analysis on the integration of ideological and political education and student managemen

At the institutional level, an integration committee or professional group can be set up to coordinate decision-making, formulate policies, and promote the implementation of integration. Such institutional setup can help eliminate the problem of poor management system, form a unified management framework, and promote the coordinated development of ideological and political education and student management. For the policy optimization of the integration of ideological and political education and student management in colleges and universities, common ideological and political and management goals can be formulated to unify the direction of ideological and political and management, so as to support each other rather than oppose each other. For example, a university has improved the interdisciplinary background and cooperation ability of teachers and managers through professional training and interdisciplinary cooperation projects. The school has set up a fusion teacher training program to invite experts in the ideological, political and management fields to exchange and train, to help teachers better understand each other's professional needs and cultivate professionals who can build a bridge between the two. Secondly, through building an integration team, the university has formed a professional team integrating ideological and political education and student management. This team not only includes not only teachers majoring in ideological and political education and management, but also professional educational administrators, forming an interdisciplinary and integration team with rich experience. This kind of team construction contributes to the transmission of information and resource sharing between education and management, and improves the overall level of comprehensive literacy cultivation. Finally, by formulating the goals and work plans of the integration team, the university has defined the responsibilities and tasks of the team members. This goal-oriented team building helps to realize the cultivation of talents and team cooperation in practical operation, and improve the integration effect.

At the same time, pay attention to the cooperation between teachers and managers to improve the participation of students.
