1. The Current Situation of Cultural Teaching in English Teaching

Teachers can also use the online teaching mode to integrate traditional culture into English teaching and create a language exchange environment for students. They can discuss traditional virtues or literary

allusions with students online in English, or they can create fixed scenes for role-playing language training. By setting up various types of teaching situations, teachers can improve students' understanding of the connection between traditional culture and English. For example, in the teaching of folk culture, the teacher first releases the teaching tasks and key points online in advance so that students can understand and prepare themselves in advance, and also focuses on teaching knowledge difficulties in offline courses so that students can realize the importance of language communication in the learning process and cultivate students' cultural awareness. After class, the key points of the course will be uploaded to the teaching platform, and other excellent teaching materials will be uploaded, so that students can learn independently. At the same time, project assignments will be set around the course theme, so that students can review and explore, and students can discuss and learn together in a group; Finally, students will share their learning insights in the form of reporting, speech and communication, and exercise their language application ability and cultural understanding ability in the process.
