The other is the use of color ink. Ink painting is one of the representative forms of traditional Chinese painting characterized by blending of water and ink, with an extended and mysterious artistic conception, which can fully inspire our association with nature.

4. The expression of artistic conception of traditional Chinese painting

4.1 Proficiency in using brush

As we all know, the colors in traditional Chinese painting are usually only black and white. Therefore, if the author wants to show different shapes and characteristics of things in his works, he must be proficient in using brush to sketch different things with different gradation and textures. 4.2 Proficiency in inking

Another foundation of traditional Chinese painting is the application of ink painting. Therefore, inking plays an important role in expressing the author's artistic conception of the painting.

4.3 Exquisite composition of picture

The artistic conception of traditional Chinese painting is also reflected in the spatial composition of picture. Only when the traditional Chinese picture is in coordinated composition, can the ink and lines be filled on this basis, and the paintings with exquisite composition will have more artistic appeal and aesthetic feeling. In this way, the whole picture can be coordinated and comfortable, and in a certain order, which is beneficial to later inking.

4.4 The technique of combining virtual thoughts with physical images

Intraditional Chinese painting, the author often expresses their artistic conception and emotion by combining virtual thoughts with physical images. Because the image of traditional Chinese painting comes from both the author's observation of the natural environment and his own subjective consciousness, so the traditional Chinese painting is not completely a tangible thing, but an imagery thing. Only in this way the artistic conception the author desired to express can be fully delivered.

Traditional Chinese painting is not a sign of modern fast-paced way of life, and is more like a kind of life
