2. 2 It is conducive to improving students' sense of trust in employment and entrepreneurship

In this case, employment and entrepreneurship may have a psychological gap because they do not understand the actual situation of the occupation, or an unacceptable situation. Therefore, as a counselor, we should have a systematic understanding of the current employment market and various employment industries, so that students can fully understand the current situation of various industries, and help students formulate career plans in line with their life development.

Finally, in terms of "value", when guiding college students' employment and entrepreneurship, counselors should make college students realize that in the process of employment and entrepreneurship, in addition to the material needs such as wages and salaries, it is more important to pursue spiritual needs other than materials.

3. 2 Establishing students' correct professional values

The job responsibility of counselors is not only to manage students' daily life and daily learning, but also to provide guidance on students' ideological and political education. Therefore, in order to effectively guide college students' employment and entrepreneurship, counselors can guide college students to establish correct professional values through ideological and political education in colleges and universities, and avoid the misunderstanding of professional values in college students' personal thoughts. Specifically, when establishing students' correct professional values, counselors can adopt the following guiding measures: The first guiding measure is to use the campus environment to imperceptibly affect students' professional values. For this, counselors can introduce some correct and healthy professional values into students' daily life on campus, and make use of campus culture to create a campus environment with strong learning atmosphere and employment atmosphere for students. The second guiding measure is to consider that with the development of society, the employer's demand for talents and the society's standards for independent entrepreneurship are constantly changing. Therefore, counselors should add the new demand for talents in the new era to the cultivation of college students' professional values, so as to help students better understand the current social demand for talents. The third point is that most college students may have some individualism. Therefore, in establishing students' correct professional values, counselors should add the educational content of patriotism collectivism, guide students to integrate the content of personal development with the development of the state, society and enterprises, and let students change from individualism to collectivism.
