

Cultivation and Innovation of Creative Talents in Colleges and Universities Under the Background of Cultural and Creative Industry

Sculpture majors need to provide students with sculpture classrooms, various tools needed for sculpture, sufficient soil, etc., in addition, schools need to regularly organize students to visit sculpture exhibitions. These majors need sufficient funds as a guarantee to meet the needs of students and improve their innovation ability.

4.2 Building a high-quality team of teachers to provide educational

guarantee for students

Therefore, building a professional teachers' team is also very important for the cultivation of creative talents in colleges and universities. Teachers in colleges and universities also need to carry out lifelong learning, always pay attention to the dynamics of their majors, grasp the direction of the times, and do a good job in each class, so that students can really learn useful things during class.

4.3 Strengthening communication with social enterprises and providing students with opportunities to play

In the last semester of colleges and universities, students are often allowed to go out for practice and get in touch with the future work content in advance. Therefore, when selecting cooperative enterprises, the school should comprehensively evaluate each enterprise and find out the most suitable enterprise for students' internship. In addition, except the internship period, it is also necessary to organize students to strengthen communication with enterprises. Compared with formal enterprises, there is a certain gap between school training and formal enterprises. Therefore, it is necessary to regularly organize students to visit enterprises. For example, in the major of animation production, the school can organize its students to study in animation production companies. Students can also give their own animation to their predecessors for communication and discussion. In the communication, they can find out their own shortcomings and accumulate some work experience. In addition, some projects of the enterprise can also be completed by drawing some students together with the

internal employees of the company, so as to provide students with the opportunity to give full play to their strength. In this way, students can not only really understand the future work content, but also encourage students to study hard and improve their innovation ability.

5. Conclusion

Only with sufficient creative talents can the society develop better. As units that directly export talents to society, colleges and universities should pay attention to talent training. Schools need to increase the investment of educational funds, strengthen the hardware facilities of schools, and improve the quality of teachers; We should also provide students with opportunities to play, use various ways to improve the teaching quality of the school, serve the students, and train students, so as to become innovative talents, and lay a solid foundation for the development of society.

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
