The university stage is a critical period for the development of college students' three views, and college teachers are also in urgent need of curriculum ideological and political education to guide them.

3. Research on the way of ideological and political integration of applied college English courses

3.1 Standardized development of "point to surface"

At present, there is no systematic model reference for the integration of ideological and political courses and professional courses.

First, the teaching and research office can set up a course ideological and political group to study course ideological and political documents every week. Teachers reflect on the teaching content, communicate the practice of integrating ideological and political elements into the college English curriculum, set an example, establish a model, and form a good atmosphere for learning to promote learning.

Secondly, different teaching and research departments can conduct special research, and hold special symposiums on ideological and political teaching methods, technical support, ideological and political elements, etc., to achieve experience and resource sharing.

Finally, colleges and universities formulate curriculum ideological and political documents in stages and steps, and form a systematic construction and development of full integration of curriculum ideological and political and college English courses

3.2 Well-designed teaching content

Judging from the overall situation of the current college English courses of ideological and political integration in higher courses, there are still some teachers who only focus on English knowledge teaching, while ignoring ideological and political education.

In terms of classroom teaching design, teachers need to improve themselves, break the shackles of traditional textbooks, develop teaching ideas, and organically integrate ideological and political elements such as patriotic thoughts, excellent ancient Chinese traditional culture, and correct world outlook, outlook on life, and values.

3.2.1 Import

Students discussed, from the reform of my country's transportation mode to guide their attention to textbook topics.

3.2.2 Explanation of knowledge points

- ①List the vehicles in the video and the words and phrases that represent the achievements in China's transportation field.
- ②The table presents the traffic topic vocabulary that needs to be mastered in this unit, and conducts short dialogue, long dialogue and chapter listening practice.

3.2.3 Expand your learning

Play a short video about the development of high-speed rail in China.

3.2.4 Topic discussion

- ①Do you think public means of transportation should be encouraged in big cities? Why?
- ②What are the factors of development of China high-speed railway?

Groups of four discuss themes, cultivate students' thinking ability, choose public transportation, shape students' good three views, and further enhance their national pride and cultural self-confidence.

3.2.5 Summarize

Students summarize what they have learned and teachers make comments. Combining the current domestic current affairs and political hot news, integrating the ideological and political elements of the curriculum, guiding students to choose public transportation, feeling the rapid development of China's high-speed rail and the great achievements in the transportation field, and enhancing national pride and self-confidence.

Teachers can use heuristic teaching methods more, focus on training students' critical thinking and inquiry ability, and realize the organic combination of teaching and educating people.

3.3 Scientific and effective teaching evaluation

First of all, change the traditional evaluation model for college teachers, change the evaluation method that focuses on student performance, make students more aware of and pay attention to the importance of moral education, and strive to
