unique physical properties, but also visually affect people's emotions and generate corresponding emotional associations.

# 2. Personalized expression language of oil painting

#### 2.1 The expression language of neoclassical painting

The eve of the French Revolution produced new classical paintings. During this period, the French bourgeoisie liked the classical style, so they hoped to express their modern views and emotions through classical art. With the outbreak of the French Revolution, these new classicisms began to break through, so that people carried out some reforms in classicism. Therefore, the artistic expressions of this period are very diverse, not only the relics of classicism, but also some innovation and revolution. It focuses on the rationality of the artwork, but does not care about the emotion of the artwork. In the works of art of this period, the pursuit of sketching is fanatical and does not pay attention to the expression of color. In form, people hope to change the actual life and express the form of some modern objects with classical laws.

### 2.2 The expressive language of romantic painting

The Neoclassical Revolution marked the beginning of Romanticism in the 19th century. During this period, works of art pursued the liberation of individuality, emphasizing the change of thought. What they pursued was not the beauty of reality, but the beauty of dreams. At this time, people preferred romance, which led to the vigorous development of art in this period. They used artworks as carriers to express their emotions. At the same time, works of art pursued more dynamic beauty than static beauty. These works are highly subjective and have little objective content. Characters in romantic works are relatively unique. Artists like to find unique things in life, and they like to find creative inspiration in exotic places, and they also like to find creative inspiration in certain literary works. In romantic painting, artistic creation is decisive, fully embodying the artist's personal emotions and rich imagination, so that the works can be more injected into the artist's soul, not just conforming to the development of the times.

# 2.3 The expression language of realistic oil painting

The Realist art movement began after French Romanticism, and artworks from this period focused on artistic expression in reality. Artists prefer to use realistic techniques and want to help people see the essence through phenomena. Take Corot's paintings as an example, his art works faithfully express nature and also incorporate his own emotions, which are very soft, so his portraits are full of poetry. Miller is known as a peasant painter. He does not have gorgeous skills, but adopts the most simple and simple painting methods, which brings intuitive feelings and deep thinking, bringing people a kind of dazed and silent mood.

#### 2.4 Expression language of Impressionist painting

Artists of this period advocated innovations in artistic expression.
