

The Necessity of Studying the Anxiety of Poor Normal University Students

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Abstract: With the deepening of educational reform, impoverished normal college students need to face various life and work problems when they move towards the society in the future. Because many students lack confidence in their future life path, they will have serious anxiety subconsciously. If we can not effectively address the negative impact of this emotion, it will not be conducive to the future development of education in China. And among the poor students, nearly 13% of the members chose to drop out because they could not afford to pay for school. Therefore, economic problems are the main reason for the anxiety of poor normal university students. In addition, many normal colleges and universities choose to establish new campuses outside the urban area. Due to the inconvenient transportation, even if poor students want to work outside, it is difficult to meet the academic and part-time requirements at the same time. Regardless of time cost and transportation cost, it is difficult for poor students to effectively solve the problem. Therefore, poor students cannot improve the poverty situation through their own efforts.

1.2 Learning problems

Poor normal university students seldom participate in remedial activities in high school because of their family circumstances. This also means that the knowledge base of poor students is relatively weak, which is inferior to other

1.3 Social issues

Some poor students feel inferior and anxious because they are looked down upon by other rich students. Some poor students, in order to maintain their dignity, choose to take out high loans or cheat their parents to create a "rich second generation" for themselves in order to obtain a higher status among the student groups. However, the social interaction relying on deception will eventually be deceiving, and such poor students will also be anxious because of the high debt [2].

1.4 Employment issues

Nowadays, the branch schools of teachers' colleges are springing up. Although most normal colleges and universities still belong to the first category, the matriculation score line of the college entrance examination has decreased year by year, which means that the entrance threshold has been lowered. As the number of students in normal colleges increases year by year, the employment of students after graduation has become a major problem. After all, the number of teachers in our country is limited. The employment competition of normal school students in the new era is like thousands of troops crossing a single wooden bridge. It is difficult for poor students to work smoothly without good interpersonal relationships. However, the current teachers' posts not only raise the requirements for diplomas, but also increase a variety of examinations, further improving the employment difficulty of students. In addition to the teaching profession, normal university students are limited to such courses as pedagogy, psychology, teaching and training, and "three characters and one painting" because their knowledge is relatively simple. Their employment scope is very narrow, and they are difficult to take on other jobs unrelated to teachers. In addition, poor normal school students have to face the "job hunting" of other non normal school students. To sum up the above problems, the increasingly serious employment pressure has also become the main factor leading to the anxiety of poor normal school students.

2. The Potential Hidden Trouble of Anxiety of Poor Normal University

2.1 Health hazard

Therefore, if we want to establish a harmonious campus and a harmonious society, it is imperative to solve the anxiety problems of poor students in normal schools.

2.3 Hidden dangers in education

If the anxiety problem of poor students in normal schools is not properly solved, poor students will accumulate grievances and injustice in their hearts for a long time due to their constant patience after long-term brewing. This is like a volcano that sleeps for a while. Once it erupts after the event, it is easy to cause serious harm to China's education. For example, there was a poor student in normal school who suffered from anxiety problems for a long time during his enrollment. For example, excessive corporal punishment of students, or instilling some negative thoughts into students, is obviously not conducive to the development of education in China.
