their children in a friendly way, for example, making every endeavor to make friends with their children. Equally important, they could buy some books related to study for their children so that they could read books whenever they want.

4.4 Focus on parent-child communication

Good parent-child communication is not only the foundation for a good parent-child relationship, but also the foundation for the implementation of family education. An important part of parent-child communication is to communicate equally and fairly in a way that is acceptable to the child, and to think from the child's point of view. Therefore, parents should consider their child as an independent-minded and self-contained person. In addition, parents need to actively participate in the parent-child activities organized by the school to enhance the relationship in the game, rather than using work as an excuse, which can easily create a gap between parents and children^[5].
