1.2 Interesting analysis

This paper takes the comprehensive course of Chinese medicine^[4] as the object, focusing on analyzing the content and structure of the teaching material in terms of the principle of interest, mainly from the text, text illustrations and after-school

exercises Analysis of the third part. It is a comprehensive TCM Chinese textbook for international students who specialize in studying TCM. According to the compilation concept of early international Chinese education textbooks. The compilation of international Chinese textbooks is based on the age, psychology, learning purpose, and learning ability of the learners. On the one hand, it affirms the importance of the principle of fun to textbook compilation, but on the other hand, there is still room for improvement.

1.2.1 The text is interesting

According to "Investigation and Research on Chinese Learners' Topic Interests and Their Matching with the Topics of Chinese as a Foreign Language" [5], the degree of interest of learners in 41 subtopics is ranked according to the order of high and low. The results of the investigation and medical-related "healthy life" and "natural science" ranked fifth and nineteenth respectively, with an average ranking of 27. 23 and 21. 50, while the topic of "hospital clinic" ranked sixth from the bottom. It can be seen that learners prefer topics such as entertainment and leisure.

Therefore, in the process of compiling textbooks, we should strengthen and consolidate students' memorization and application of words from the aspects of pronunciation, English translation, Chinese annotation and extended reading. ^[6]

1.2.2 Text illustrations are interesting

The illustrations selected in the textbook are presented in black and white, and the quality of the illustrations is generally high, which is in line with the central idea of the text. However, in addition to focusing on quality, quantity, size, color, location and other factors, the illustrations of the text should also enrich the materials, the distribution should be relatively balanced, and it should be able to promote learners' understanding of the text. Appropriate illustrations can be added to the text, which can stimulate learners' interest in learning, help learners understand and remember the teaching content, and be more conducive to the development of learning activities.

2. Analysis of interesting teaching practice in "Comprehensive Course of Chinese In Traditional Chinese Medicine"

2.1 Create interesting situational teaching

In teaching, it is necessary to determine the scenario preset according to the actual needs of students and the content of teaching, and improve the quality of teaching, which can be implemented in the following ways. (1) Use stories to create scenarios. Through stories, the classroom is fun, teaching in the middle of the school, teaching in the middle of the school, using a pleasant and relaxed atmosphere to learn knowledge, attract the interest of learners and improve attention. The teaching method based on practical operation and teacher guidance not only reflects the professional characteristics, but also enhances the students' perceptual understanding, making it the main body of the classroom, and actively participating in the classroom practice activities, thereby effectively stimulating their learning interest and mobilizing their enthusiasm for learning.

3. Prospects of Teachers of the International Chinese of Chinese Medicine and the Preparation of Chinese Teaching Materials in Chinese Medicine

Whether it is a single Chinese foundation or a single teaching of TCM theory, it may lead to teachers focusing on one of the parties in the teaching process, thus becoming a simple Chinese class or a Chinese medicine class. Therefore, the supporting TCM Chinese teacher book allows teachers to get scientific and professional help when they encounter difficulties in teaching lessons or do not have enough grasp of TCM expertise. In the process of compiling Chinese teaching materials for Traditional Chinese medicine, the construction of its supporting resources, such as audio, video, pictures, and reading materials, also needs to be paid more attention to.
