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Exploring the Path of Language and Culture Education from the Perspective of Cross-cultural Education

1. Main problems in college foreign language practice teaching from the perspective of cross-cultural communication

2. Effective path of language practice teaching from the perspective of cross-cultural communication

2.1 Put conceptual innovation first in foreign language practice teaching

Therefore, in the practical teaching of foreign language in colleges and universities from the perspective of cross-cultural communication, teachers should help students organize learning thinking and propose solutions to communication problems. In addition, in the process of teaching, students should be taught to use their mother tongue and foreign language at the same time, and understand the meaning of foreign language with the help of mother tongue, which is actually deeply impressed in students' minds. Therefore, in actual teaching, teachers can use the role of new media to broadcast some information about the living habits and traditional customs of different countries to students, so that students can obtain corresponding cultural knowledge from it, which plays a very important role in improving the level of language and culture education.

First, lead students to watch some videos of specific cultural scenes, and then organize students to imitate the dialogue scenes in the videos. Secondly, in the process of watching the video, organize students to discuss the similarities and differences between Chinese culture and other cultures. Through this way of analysis and discussion, let students have a certain understanding of foreign culture, such as eating habits, conversation habits, etc., to avoid mistakes in the communication process. Finally, after the cultural explanation, the language teaching will be started, such as what new words are in the video clip, and what grammatical applications are reflected in the dialogue.

2.3 Integrate cultural education into foreign language practice teaching

In the context of globalization, intercultural communicative competence is more important than the application of language competence. Therefore, In the teaching of foreign language courses, teachers should teach students correct and acceptable language, and let students know what is suitable for the target society and what is not. Only when students have a certain understanding of their culture and tradition in the process of language learning can they avoid mistakes in the process of communication. According to the current foreign language learning standards, the emphasis in foreign language courses is not only on grammar and vocabulary, but also on the expression of language. The purpose of this is to make students in different regional cultures interested in learning, so that they can understand that the world is diverse, and the world's culture is also diverse, so that they can learn other countries' culture with a positive attitude, So as to achieve the purpose of cross-cultural communication. Therefore, in the actual teaching process, it is necessary to let students understand the future working environment, living environment and social environment, so that they can understand the basic rules of communication and behavior related to different cultures, and focus on

the interactive method of foreign language teaching. Secondly, students are encouraged to use foreign language for communication in a specific communication environment, so as to exercise their oral and listening skills, thus improving their ability to cope with the knowledge society of cross-cultural communication, and avoiding the phenomenon of cultural conflict in the process of communication. Finally, let students constantly reflect on their own culture in the learning process, and then Pei Yan's ability to think independently, so that students can make corresponding responses to specific situations, and can make corresponding responses in actual situations, so as to improve students' awareness and understanding of the culture of other countries. In addition, teachers should build corresponding cross-cultural fields according to different scenarios, so that students can understand the diversity in different cultures.

Conclusion:

In short, in the context of the rapid development of China's economy, the frequency of international exchanges is also increasing, and the cultivation of students' intercultural communicative competence has become an inevitable trend.
