At the same time, it can also improve the social recognition of student associations; Third, give play to the exemplary role of college students' innovation and entrepreneurship projects. All colleges and universities can give full play to the exemplary role of innovation and entrepreneurship projects of college students; Fourth, carry out distinctive discipline competition activities. Each university can make full use of its own advantages to build its own characteristic brand of discipline competition activities; Fifth, hold professional academic lectures. Colleges and universities can help college students to establish a correct view of learning by holding professional academic lectures. Sixth, strengthen the training for the leaders and members of student associations. Colleges and universities shall organize relevant personnel to conduct professional training for the leaders and members of student associations; Seventh, holding regular discipline competition results display activities. Colleges and universities can enhance college students' awareness of discipline competition activities by holding the exhibition of discipline competition results. Ninth, extensive absorption of social resources. Colleges and universities can actively contact social resources to provide guidance and help to college student associations.

3.3 Give full play to students' subjective initiative, and integrate the concept of learning peer culture into the course of discipline competition

Colleges and universities as the export of knowledge, college students as an important source of knowledge, is the main source of students in colleges and universities, but also an important force for peer culture construction.
