Another example: for quarrels and fights between classmates, the past may only let students write a letter of criticism, or call parents to the school to talk, but the content of the letter of criticism is mostly similar, and there is no true feeling. However, some students suggest that calling parents will also delay parents' work, so it is better to let the students who have conflicts participate in a game that can help them resolve conflicts. For example, two people stand on the same stool together, maintain balance for one minute, and let the two people help each other or hug each other to complete the task, and try to eliminate the resentment of both sides through this process. After the challenge is over, both parties should be encouraged to apologize to each other. Such an apology is more sincere than a letter of criticism, and it is easier to resolve the conflict between students.

In addition, The process of the class teacher taking the initiative to discuss and improve the content of class rules with the students is actually to lead everyone to reflect on the violations and disciplinary behaviors that are prone to occur, create conditions for the conscious formation of the rule consciousness, and enhance the concept of right and wrong. Such moral education penetration is not only natural and effective, but also the class rules developed by the students themselves will be more novel and convincing, and take the initiative to comply with them.

3.2 Organize practical activities effectively

The new curriculum reform emphasizes that the educational guidance for students should be carried out in the way of personal experience as much as possible, so that everyone can get a deeper understanding in the learning practice, so as to enhance the effect of moral education work, so as not to become superficial. Through the organization of various practical activities, more students can be guided to gradually transform the good qualities cultivated by the head teacher into their actual behaviors, laying the foundation for better learning and growth in the future^[4]. You can also during the holiday, led by the class teacher to do a day around the school sanitation workers, pick up the garbage on the road, remove the small advertisements on the wall and so on. Let the students really contribute to the urban cleaning with their own practical actions, enhance the awareness of students to care for the environment as a whole, and in the practice of participation, students can also have a real experience of the hard work of the sanitation workers, and can respect and appreciate the sanitation workers from the heart.

The use of traditional festivals can not be ignored, we can organize people to participate in various practical activities in some special festivals, so that we can not only feel the traditional cultural atmosphere, but also create conditions for moral education. For example, during the Qingming Festival, we can organize people to go to museums and memorial halls to review history, so

that students can remember history and take history as a mirror at any time. You can also organize the activities of appreciating the moon during the Mid-Autumn Festival, and encourage you to share the poems you know about the Mid-Autumn Festival, so that you can fully appreciate the charm and artistic conception of Chinese poetry, and also enhance the love of high school students for traditional Chinese culture as a whole^[5].

3.3 Pay close attention to mental health

For high school students who are facing greater pressure to study and are still in adolescence, some psychological problems are inevitable, such as anxiety about their studies, anxiety about not being able to deal with interpersonal relations and so on, which will affect the physical and mental health of students to varying degrees. Therefore, in the concrete implementation of moral education, The head teacher should pay close attention to the students' mental health. First of all, it is necessary to establish a harmonious teacher-student relationship with the class students, strive to become more students' good teachers and friends, encourage students to share their inner thoughts or problems with the homeroom teachers, so as to increase the communication between teachers and students. In this process, teachers should adhere to the respect, sincere attitude to listen to the expression of students, and then strive to find an effective way to solve the problem together with students, truly take into account the students' own feelings, and must not belittle students. To this end, the class teacher can contact reality, expand communication channels, encourage everyone to try to increase online communication by wechat, qq, etc., and can also communicate on paper by writing letters. It can also allow students to leave anonymous messages under their own network message boards, so that everyone can freely express their true inner thoughts, and then the class teacher will reply one by one, which will eliminate the psychological pressure of students and also help emotional communication!

In addition, We can also regularly organize class meetings on the theme of mental health, make full use of class meeting time to help everyone remove negative emotions, and guide everyone to discuss psychological problems that are easy to produce in high school students. For example, "How to look at the imperfect self", students can be encouraged to stand on the platform to reintroduce themselves to everyone, and bravely say some of their shortcomings, which can not only narrow the distance between teachers and students, but also encourage everyone to understand themselves objectively and completely. Finally, the head teacher summarized, guiding everyone to adhere to a peaceful attitude to look at their shortcomings in study and life, and positively accept their imperfections. On this basis, I will strive to improve my character or behavioral deficiencies, so that I can get continuous improvement and promotion. In addition, putting up posters about mental health, or getting everyone together to create a few blackboard newspapers related to mental health, can also help everyone create a greener and healthier classroom atmosphere^[7].

Conclusion:

All in all, with the continuous implementation of the new curriculum reform, many high schools have greatly improved their emphasis on moral education. In particular, class teachers, as teachers who spend more time with students and shoulder the task of moral education, should not only adhere to the concept of student-oriented, but also adhere to various new challenges and problems in the new era. In addition to paying attention to the effective organization of various activities, the head teacher should also pay attention to the role of example, by further standardizing themselves to bring subtle influence to students and enhance the effect of moral education.
