Excellent Sino foreign cooperative education project managers are the foundation for improving the quality of management work. Therefore, China needs to attach importance to the cultivation of excellent management personnel in order to meet the needs of management work. Universities can organize relevant management personnel to study abroad and improve their management

thinking. Colleges and universities also need to organize administrative personnel to study by themselves during their spare time to realize the rapid improvement of management ability, so as to satisfy the reform of education ideas in colleges and promote the development of colleges and universities in our country.

4. Conclusion

As the main battlefield of education, universities will greatly affect the development of China's economy. In this regard, many colleges and universities in our country have begun to set up Chinese-foreign cooperative education programs, which can comply with the development of The Times and meet the needs of national economic development. However, there are certain problems in the management of Sino foreign cooperative education projects in higher education institutions, which greatly affect the quality of teaching and are not conducive to the development of universities.
