banks of the Yellow River and the river beach. Through the rational use of sand, it creates an eco-tourist attraction with local characteristics. In addition, there are many other cultural tourist attractions with local characteristics such as Shdao Garden.

Showing obvious characteristics of openness in the process of regional cultural inheritance. The regional culture of Gansu was formed through continuous evolution in the long history, so it gradually formed a unique culture and art in the process of development, which is also an important content of people's life and production, as well as an important carrier of their spiritual culture in Gansu. In the process of regional cultural inheritance, the feature of openness is a very important aspect. Through the characteristics of openness, more people can understand the cultural characteristics of Gansu, and further stimulate people's interest in the art creation and art activities in Gansu, so as to promote the development of local fine arts.

2.The Relationship Between Fine Art Creation and Regional Culture in Gansu Province

The Tibetan and Han people are the main ethnic minorities in Gansu Province. In the long process of life and development, these ethnic groups have formed their own unique regional culture. The Hui nationality is also one

of the important ethnic minorities in Gansu Province, which has strong ethnic characteristics and religious color. These nationalities have formed their own unique regional cultural characteristics, which is also an important reason for the unique regional cultural characteristics presented in the art works in Gansu province^[3] _o

Take the Tibetan people as an example. As one of the important ethnic minorities in Gansu province, the Tibetan people has a long history and is one of the four major sects of Tibetan Buddhism in China. The religious belief in the Tibetan areas has a profound influence on the Tibetan art creation, and its unique religious color has also become an indispensable part of the Tibetan art creation. In Tibetan areas, people often express their understanding of life, nature and faith through painting forms. For example, Buddha Pearl and Highland barley Field can see the embodiment of the expression of regional cultural characteristics in Tibetan art creation. In addition, Gansu province is one of the important provinces in northwest China, and its geographical location is relatively remote. Due to the relatively remote geographical location, it also causes a certain gap between Gansu province and other provinces in the development process. In addition, Gansu province has special topographic features such as plateau, Gobi, desert and snow-capped mountains, and these special geographical characteristics also create the unique regional cultural characteristics of Gansu province. For example, Zhangye Danxia landform works "Book of Heaven" and "Three strings" are formed by this unique regional cultural characteristics.

3. Epilogue

In the process of art creation, art workers should deeply understand and master the characteristics of local regional culture, integrate regional cultural elements into the art creation, and apply it to their own artistic creation.
