Research and practice of class management strategy in secondary vocational education

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Abstract: This paper aims to study and discuss the importance of class management in secondary vocational education, analysis of the current situation, strategies and practical cases. By literature analysis, case study and other methods, this paper expounds the definition, objectives, tasks and basic principles of class management in secondary vocational education, and deeply analyzes the factors and main problems affecting class management in secondary vocational education.
